

Baltimore City Department of Transportation
Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Goals for
Upcoming Federal Fiscal Years (FFYs) 2017-2019

The City of Baltimore's Department of Transportation announces with Code of Federal Regulation, 49 CFR 26.45, the Proposed Overall Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Goals for its Federal Transit Administration (FTA) funded programs and awards for Federal Fiscal Years 2017-2019. Using calculated methodology, the determined DBE goal for the identified fiscal period will be 12.82%, of which 2.96% is race neutral and 9.86% is race conscious. .

Information concerning the rationale and methodology used to formulate the overall goal will be available for inspection during normal business hours for 30 days following the date of this notice.
