
PUMP TRACK

Bird launching Whill Electric Wheelchair, delivery fee (\$5-15) will apply Spin launching e-bikes by the end of the year










Updates DOT – Automated Bike Counters

Updates: DOT Bike Program & Projects

Bikeways and Transportation Alternative Program (TA or TAP) Awards:

Awarded three of four applications

Did not receive Bikeways funds for construction of the West Baltimore Blvd.

project

Will apply for additional funding in CIP

- MLK Sidepath: Eutaw Place to Russell St.
 - Received both Bikeways and TAP funds totaling \$520,800
 - Design funds for 30% to Final Design
- Automated Bike Counters Phase 2
 - Bikeways Award for \$98,400
 - Install potentially another 10 counters







 - Erdman to Montebello Terrace












Bike Plan Update

- City Planning Commission is required to adopt an updated plan every six years
- Last major Bike Master Plan update in 2015
- DOT has provided minor updates every two years until schedule impacted by COVID
- DOT has coordinated with DOP and the Planning Commission for this update
- The timeline for completion is first quarter of 2023
