# **Dockless Vehicle Update**

- Numbers for Scooters
  - o October 2018- April 20022, total trips were 5,176,133
  - o Monthly Trip Average: 120, 375
  - Average Low-Income Person takes on average 40 trips a month vs. Average rider takes 12
  - o Some Dips because of Weather, back to 2019 numbers (highest years)
- Application Period
  - Just Closed Application period
  - o Renewed Spin automatically because they had the highest on grade scale

- Adaptive Vehicles request for more vehicles
- Personal Delivery Devices BCDOT researching on permitting and regulations

#### Bike Counters

- Automatic Bike Counter Public Outreach Strategy Updated
  - Revised Maps to make more user friendly
  - Will be emailed to members of bike groups
- Focus Group -requesting 10 volunteers
- Metro Count Temporary Automatic Bike Counter Pilot
  - o Tube Style Counters
  - o Will be from May 19<sup>th</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup>
  - o At North of Intersection at Cathedral Street and West Centre Street
  - Working to try different kinds of Counter
- Question about How Counter Works, does the speed matter?
  - o Speed is Negligible, it counts the number of tires that go over the tubes
- Question about Video/Photo Counters?
  - We are working on this
  - o Participants, there are privacy concerns
