Permit Updates

90 Day Permit Extension: Filed with Legislative Reference, effective June 9, 2020

- State of Emergency lifted
- BCDOT Releases final Rules & Regulation for 30 days of Public Comment
- BCDOT Releases Final Rules & Regulations and Public Comment Report
- Permit Application Opens
- Permits are awarded 60 days after State of Emergency is lifted
- New Permits become active 90 days after State of Emergency is lifted

Permit Updates

Comment Week:

- Most changes technical, few comments:
 - Tire Size, fleet increase size
 - Communication of laws location in app and clarity
 - Customer Service channels and response time
- Overall National trends are towards select, long term contracts as cities are learning more about how dockless programs may function. Cities looking for companies which have demonstrated:
 - Compliance with R&R
 - Engaged with the community—how do we gauge and integrate community ratings? Current Data sources:
 - 311 complaints
 - Monthly reporting of complaints from companies
 - Survey results indirect questions








Daily Average Vehicles Deployed* and Total Daily Trips



- Green skips and striping next






Preferred Parking Spot Analysis

- Majority, but not all spots, effective
 - The ratio of vehicles parked in the 20m radii compared to 100m radii improved
 - The percent change of vehicles parked in the PPS radius was higher in the 20m radii than larger radii


Corral Installation

- Finish Equity Zones and follow the max 25% in one zone distribution
- Prioritize waterfront (reduce vandalism)
- MTA MOU signed by the City





% of Spin Vehicles Parked Within




PPS	% Change at 20M	% Change at 20-40m
