Department of Transportation Announces Changes **in Two Speed Camera Locations**

BALTIMORE, MD – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation today announces minor changes in two automated enforcement locations along West University Parkway, as part of the City’s Automated Traffic Violation Enforcement System (ATVES).

The automated speed enforcement cameras will begin implementation on January 24, 2020 and will be placed at the following locations:

- 000 West University Parkway EB
- 200 blk West University Parkway WB

Baltimore’s ATVES program uses automated speed, red light, and Commercial Vehicle Height Monitoring System cameras to promote safe driving habits in our City. This program is designed to increase safety by reducing driver speeds in school zones, decrease the incidence of vehicles running red lights, and for commercial vehicles, reducing traffic congestion and damage to streets, homes, businesses, and other infrastructure on posted (signed) streets.

The block ranges and intersections listed for all locations below are approximations for the enforcement zones. Enforcement at all locations may be on a temporary, rotating, or permanent basis.
